For consideration in the scholarship competition all Application Packets must be post marked or electronically submitted by **September 14, 2007**. No exceptions will be made.

**The recipients of the 2007 Kentucky Poultry Federation Scholarships must be a child or grandchild of an employee of a Kentucky poultry complex or a child or grandchild of a grower who is a member of the Kentucky Poultry Federation. The scholarship check is awarded by the Kentucky Poultry Federation after you take or send proof of registration from a college, university, or technical training program to the Kentucky Poultry Federation Office.

To be considered for the Kentucky Poultry Federation scholarships you must be enrolled for Fall '07 semester at a college, university, or technical training program. **You must be the child or grandchild of an employee for a Kentucky poultry company (Equity Group – Kentucky Division, LLC; Cal-Maine Foods, Inc.; Cobb Vantress, Inc.; Perdue Farms, Inc.; Pilgrim's Pride, Inc.; or Tyson Foods, Inc.) or a child or grandchild of a grower who is a member of the Kentucky Poultry Federation. Recipients must be residents of Kentucky.**
