RE: 2014 Kentucky Poultry Federation Scholarship

The Kentucky Poultry Federation is looking for graduating High School seniors (Spring 2014) or enrolled students who are attending a college, university, or technical training program to be recipients of the KPF Scholarships. These students must have good character and determination to succeed.

Through the generosity of our members and allied companies, scholarships have been established to assist graduating high school students or students currently attending a college or university to continue their education. These scholarships were created to benefit the children and grandchildren of our poultry complex employees, growers and allied members. The Kentucky Poultry Federation Board of Directors and members established this fund to help young students continue their academic careers or receive additional training in another area beyond high school.

The Kentucky Poultry Federation will be awarding four students \$1,000 scholarships each. The recipients of the 2014 Kentucky Poultry Federation Scholarships must be a child or grandchild of an employee of a Kentucky poultry complex or a child or grandchild of a grower who is a member of the Kentucky Poultry Federation or a child or grandchild of an allied member of the Kentucky Poultry Federation.

Recipients must be residents of Kentucky. Three scholarships have been specifically earmarked for a child or grandchild of a poultry grower who is a member of the Kentucky Poultry Federation.

Interested candidates please read the enclosed Application Rules and Instructions carefully and determine your eligibility for the scholarship. If you are definitely not eligible, please do not return the Application Packet. The award winners will be announced at our 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Kentucky Poultry Festival Hall of Fame Banquet on Saturday, October 11, 2014 at the University Plaza Holiday Inn, Bowling Green, Kentucky. For consideration in the scholarship competition all Application Packets must be post marked or electronically submitted by **Monday, June 30, 2014**. No exceptions will be made. # 2014 KENTUCKY POULTRY FEDERATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Applications must be submitted by Monday, June 30, 2014. No applications postmarked or electronically submitted later than Monday, June 30, 2014, will be acknowledge or considered. No exceptions will be permitted.
- 2. The Recipients of the scholarships will be announced and are required to attend the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Kentucky Poultry Festival Hall of Fame Banquet on Saturday, October 11, 2014 at the University Plaza Holiday Inn, Bowling Green, Kentucky
- 3. The scholarship check is awarded by the Kentucky Poultry Federation after you take or send proof of registration from a college, university, or technical training program to the Kentucky Poultry Federation Office.
- 4. To be considered for the Kentucky Poultry Federation scholarships you must be a graduating senior (Spring 2014) or an enrolled student who is attending a college, university, or technical training program by the Fall Semester '14.
- 5. A scholarship winner can only be awarded the Kentucky Poultry Federation scholarship twice during their college enrollment period.
- 6. You must be the child or grandchild of an <a href="employee">employee</a> for a Kentucky poultry company (Keystone Foods Kentucky Division, LLC; Cal-Maine Foods, Inc.; Cobb Vantress, Inc.; Perdue Farms, Inc.; Pilgrim's Pride, Inc.; Farbest Foods Inc.; or Tyson Foods, Inc.) or a child or grandchild of a <a href="mailto:grower">grower</a> who is a member of the Kentucky Poultry Federation or a child or grandchild of an <a href="mailto:allied member">allied member</a> of the Kentucky Poultry Federation.
- 7. Recipients must be residents of Kentucky.
